We have signed a contract with <u>Casavant Freres</u> of Saint-Hyacinth, Quebec for the restoration, refurbishment, and enhancement of our organ at Grace! The removal of the existing organ will start in early October and should wrap up by mid-November.

If you haven't yet seen the "before" version of the organ's innards, be sure to join Director of Music Vince for a tour of the inside of the organ chambers while there's still time. Reservations aren't necessary; just meet Vince by the entrance to the church around 11:15am.

Education for Ministry (EfM for short) is a program of personal renewal and spiritual transformation based upon individual study and practice. Deeply rooted in the Christian tradition, open to all, EfM invites us to engage in study, worship, and theological reflection. Guided by trained mentors, participants meet each week through the school year in a small group for 2.5-3 hours. 
