Apartment Setup for Refugees - Monday!



Grace Church has a longstanding partnership with Dorcas International - the agency responsible for settling 90% of the refugees who come to call Rhode Island their home. Many of these new residents come from refugee camps where they've lived for years with few, if any, of the possessions and mementos we all cherish.

As part of our partnership with Dorcas, we are forming a team to prepare an apartment for a new family of refugees on Monday, January 6 - can you join us? This spiritually powerful work involves all aspects of making the stranger welcome, so we need folks who can do all sorts of things - from loading in items to scrubbing sinks and tubs to vacuuming. We

also need people to make beds, wash and put away dishes, organize closets with towels and linens, and generally help create a home for refugees who may not have had a home for many years.




