Ash Wednesday and Lent -Next Week

The Lenten season starts soon with Ash Wednesday next week, on March 5. Make plans now to join us for one of our Ash Wednesday services:

- A spoken Eucharist with the Imposition of Ashes at Grace's regular noontime service.
- A Choral Holy Eucharist with the Imposition of Ashes at 7pm.



Each week, beginning Friday, March 7, join us at noon for the short liturgy of The Way of the Cross (also called "Stations of the Cross"). During this lunchtime service, participants walk to 14 stations posted throughout the church commemorating Christ's journey to Mount Calvary and his death on the Cross.




Hallway Floor Repaired
