A Loss to Our Grace Family

We are saddened to share that longtime member Virginia Chase died on August 22 after a short illness. Virginia and her husband Peter - an Episcopal priest - retired here in 1986 after an extensive career in New England and New York.

There will be a funeral here at Grace next Thursday, September 4, at 2pm; all are welcome to attend.

Organ Project Update

The Grace Church Organ Project is moving along! Final drawings of the new console have been approved, detailed drawings of the chamber interiors and layout are nearing completion, and much of the on-site prep work needed here is complete. While the team at Casavant has been hard at work in



Canada, it has been inspiring to see the Grace Church community join together here in supporting this effort.

We have already raised over \$3.7 million towards our goal of \$4.1 million and now have only a year before the organ returns. We are hoping for gifts or pledges to reach our \$4 million goal by October for the costs of the restoration, renovation, and reinstallation, and we will continue seeking funds to build a \$100,000 endowment for the care and maintenance of the completed organ. 
