

In the meantime, our neighbors and their families still need to eat.

Grace Church's response to this challenging time has been extraordinary. Our friends at Pete & Andy's Food Pantry have been

grateful for your support. Rev. Maryalyce Sullivan of Sts. Peter and Andrew Episcopal Church (Pete & Andy's home) shared their gratitude earlier this week:

Thank you so much-we had 255 families on Saturday and with the help from Grace and the Boy Scouts, we had enough food to feed all of them. How we actually did it not sure, St. Peter's & St. Andrew's is pretty small but we managed to and it actually all went well. We deeply appreciate the groceries and cards and most of all the support. It means so much to have your support.

As we near the Thanksgiving holiday, your donations are valued and appreciated by these families. **Please bring your contributions of food and gift cards this Sunday**.

  what you can spare, and bring those items to church on Sunday. (Due to the
  chance for breakage, glass containers are not preferred.) All donations will be
  turned over to Pete & Andy's Food Pantry for them to share with our friends and
