Toy & Pajama Drive Starts Sunday



Here are just a few:

- When the parish office opened on November 17, we were surprised to see a huge pile of donated items (photo above) for Pete & Andy's Food Pantry. It was completely unexpected...AND this collection **doubled** the amount we delivered that week!
- In the Sunday collection on November 16, one family donated \$1,000 in Walmart gift cards remarkable! (You'll recall that the week prior, a family donated \$600 in Walmart gift cards.) These gifts are especially welcome as we come to Thanksgiving and families begin planning Christmas for their children.
- Last week, a member stopped by the parish office to drop off a grocery donation for Pete & Andy's...then gave us the "emergency cash" tucked in her wallet. A humbling gesture that will mean so much to those in need!

It's a privilege to witness how generously you continue to give during this stressful time for so many of our neighbors. **On their behalf, thank you.**

As we near the end of the year, our work continues. Please bring your contributions of food and gift cards this Sunday.

- Purchase some extra dry goods at the store and dig through your pantry to see
 what you can spare, and bring those items to church on Sunday. (Due to the
 chance for breakage, glass containers are not preferred.) All donations will be
 turned over to Pete & Andy's Food Pantry for them to share with our friends and
 neighbors in Providence.
- And if you'd like to donate a gift card or two, Rev. Maryalyce Sullivan at Sts. Peter and Andrew advises that cards for Walmart or Price Rite both of which are in their neighborhood are very helpful! (Please put gift-card donations in an envelope with your name on it if you'd like that donation reflected on your giving statement.)
